BOWLS POLISHER

It was raised again at the AGM that purchasing a bowls polisher machine should be considered. At the last Board Meeting this was discussed with the following conclusion:

- the considerable price (\$2,500 to \$3,500 more for a self-funding machine – coin in the slot)
- our restrictions on available space
- and the unlikelihood of improved bowling results.

It was also noted that decisions around whether and how often to polish a player's

bowls tends to be a personal choice. On balance, the Committee decided not to proceed with the proposed purchase.

CLUB LIQUOR LICENCE

As members we must protect the club's liquor licence. The licence will be an asset to the Club for the years to come.

The Licensee is jointly and severally the members of the Board of Management of the Club.

Your compliance with the following would be much appreciated.

Our Club is fully licensed for the supply of alcohol from the bar to be consumed on the apron in front of the clubhouse and the green surrounds (see map) during the hours:

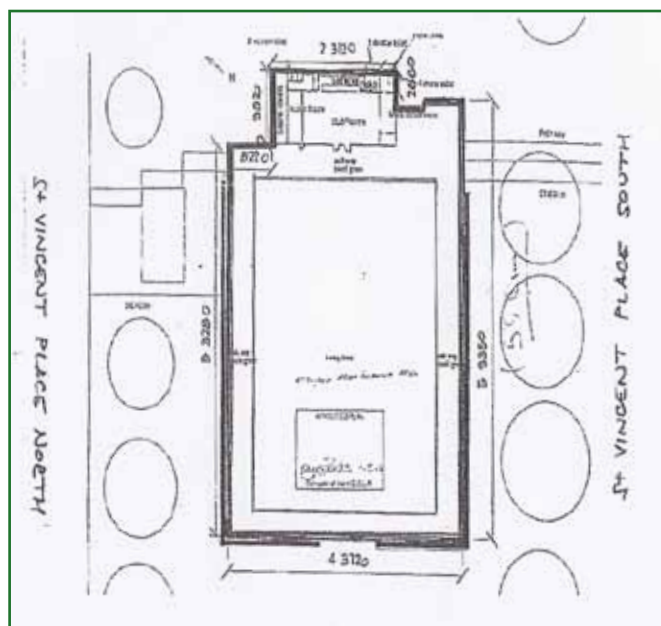
- Until 9pm Monday to Saturday
- Until 8pm Sunday

Only a member with Responsible Service of Alcohol Certificate (RSA) can serve the alcohol.

- Alcohol may not be taken or consumed outside of the areas indicated on the map.
- No alcohol may be consumed after these hours outside the clubhouse as stipulated above.
- Alcohol can be supplied and consumed within the Clubhouse until 11pm Monday to Saturday and until 8pm Sunday.
- All empty or part consumed cans and bottles must be binned before departing the clubhouse.

For Pennant matches: Members and guests may purchase alcoholic drinks at the bar and consume them inside the clubhouse or outside on the apron in front of the clubhouse and on the green surrounds.

For Club Member activities: Members may purchase alcoholic drinks at the bar and consume them inside the clubhouse or outside on the apron in



front of the clubhouse and on the green surrounds.

For Bowling Functions: we must ensure compliance with the bowling function rules. These form a condition of our licence.

- Each guest must complete the guest register recording the name and address of the guest. The guest register is stored in the bar.
- All guest functions must have some bowling activity.
- There shall be no live or amplified music outdoors.
- A member with a RSA certificate must service the alcohol.
- Guests must not bring their own alcohol onto the premises.
- Members and guests must depart the park surroundings within 30 minutes of bar closure without causing nuisance or annoyance to neighbours.

The above decision was given by VCAT and the Victorian Commission for Liquid Regulation issued August 1, 2012.
