### **CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023-24**

Greetings Parkers one and all,

I am writing this piece to encourage every member of the club, regardless of experience or ability, to consider signing up for one or more of the club competitions. Participation is open to all club members who are financial, other than social, dual or permit members. There is a fee of \$5, payable on sign up, for each event you choose to participate in.

There are many competitions to choose from. Most are open to all eligible members however, there are two women's only events and the name says it all for the mixed pairs. The full conditions of play will be posted on the club notice board. In summary, they are as follows:

Singles competitions are four bowl singles with the first to 25 points declared the winner however, the under 18 competition is first to 15.

The President's Handicap (handicaps allocated by tournament director) is first to 16 shots and the Club Proportional first to 100 points. The scoring for the Proportional is very different (see conditions of play).

The Club Novice is limited to those who began bowling on or after 1 September 2021 and the Club Minor to those who have not previously won a club singles title.

Pairs competitions are three bowl pairs with 15 ends for all rounds and sudden death (as per penalty shoutouts in football) if tied after 15 ends. Triples are two bowl triples played under the same conditions as the pairs.

Ladies' singles and pairs and the mixed pairs are self-explanatory and played under the same rules as singles and pairs as described above.

It is important that everyone understands that the club rules do not permit seeding of players in any of the competitions. That means that the draw will be random even if it means that two top players are pitted against each other in the first round.
